2.6.2 - Attainment of Programme Outcomes and Course Outcomes as evaluated by the institution

The assessment tools and processes used for measuring the attainment of POs / PSOs:

The program outcomes and Program Specific outcomes are assessed with the help of course outcomes of the relevant courses through direct and indirect methods. Direct methods are provided through direct examinations or observations of student knowledge or skills against measurable course outcomes. At the end of each semester, the course outcomes are measured.

Three internal tests are conducted per semester to evaluate the performance of the student in answering each question. Mapping is carried out with the respective COs for assessing the attainment level of the specific CO of the subject.

Exit surveys, alumni surveys, and employer feedback are collected to gather insights on how well the program prepared students for their careers, aligning with POs.

Outcomes are regularly reviewed and analysed, leading to curriculum updates and improvements based on PO attainment results.

By using these methods, institutions ensure that the POs are being effectively achieved.
