## **6.5.2 - The institution reviews its teaching-learning process, structures and methodologies of operation and learning outcomes at periodic intervals through its IQAC as per norms**

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) consistently evaluates and implements measures to enhance the quality of the teaching-learning process. An Academic Calendar is meticulously prepared in advance, prominently displayed, and circulated across the Institute. This calendar is adhered to strictly and includes details such as admission schedules for various programs, summer, winter, and mid-term vacation periods, examination timelines, and result declaration dates.

All newly admitted students are required to attend a comprehensive Orientation Programme. During this program, students are introduced to the Institute's philosophy, unique education system, teaching-learning methodologies, continuous evaluation framework, compulsory core courses, co-curricular activities, discipline, and cultural ethos. Additionally, students are given a guided tour of the campus to familiarize themselves with the available facilities.

To ensure the smooth functioning of classes, the CEO, Principal, Heads of Departments (HoDs), and members of the Discipline Committee conduct random visits. Class Committees, comprising students and faculty, are convened regularly to gather feedback and address any concerns, fostering an environment for continuous improvement. Faculty members also collect individual feedback for their respective courses, which is further complemented by feedback sessions conducted by the CEO or Principal. Students are encouraged to share their suggestions and concerns directly with their respective HoDs.

The collected feedback is systematically analyzed and shared with Deans, HoDs, and individual faculty members. Based on the recommendations of the IQAC, the teaching-learning processes are reviewed and enhanced.

Notable initiatives undertaken over the past five years include:

1. Introduction of online fee payment systems.
2. Organization of Curriculum Development Workshops across various subjects.
3. Implementation of green initiatives on campus, including tree plantation drives, the establishment of a Biodiversity Park, installation of a biogas plant, solar photovoltaic power systems, and promotion of e-vehicles.
4. Establishment of Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with prestigious institutes and universities.
5. Submission of applications for NIRF, ISO, and NBA certifications.
